Remedial classes play a crucial role in enhancing educational equity by ensuring that all students have the opportunity to succeed academically. Such category of students is identified based on their performance in the unit test examination of the Semesters I, III & IV. The primary purpose of remedial classes is to offer targeted assistance to students who may be experiencing difficulties in certain subjects. These classes identify areas where students are facing challenges and provide them with personalized instruction to help them overcome these challenges. Remedial classes are not only about addressing academic shortcomings but also about building students confidence and motivation.

Further some students come forward voluntarily for extra inputs in any of the subjects. It is also observed that few students are facing difficult in some subjects. The details of the remedial Classes like number of students, their identification, the subject and the faculty taking the classes are enclosed. It is observed that such classes have a positive impact on the performance of the students. It is also observed that the confidence of the students is boosted up at the end of the sessions. This is reflected in the result analysis of the final exams.






