Title: Safety of Girls Students- Ensuring Women Equality

Objective:

College takes up women education and women issue seriously by ensuring and by conducting various activities for the boosting morale of girl's students towards better prospects. Therefore some committees are formed to work in this perspective to achieve the goal that is safety and women equality.

Context:

Gender inequality is a universal problem. The institute tries to contribute to the process of lending equality by improving and enhancing the female intake capacity. To bridge this gap, it is necessary to achieve the empowerment of women. The society can flourish if women treated well and given opportunities.

Practices:

As a part of gender equality, the institution always ensure better participation of women students in employment as well as in the intake. The gender audit report of the college and the other committee's works give testimony to this approach.

Gender Audit Report of the Institute:

Out of 18 teaching staff of the college, 07 are female which constitute 44% whereas male teaching staff is 56%. The female teaching staff is very close to male teaching staff. With reference to night college, it is quite good sign. This indicates that there is a creation of favorable environment for women in the night college. The girl's students are allotted a special common room which provides leisure and relaxation and a certain amount of freedom.

Out of a total of 403 students, 106 students are girls and 297 boys which is in more number. If we go through the night college prospective, it is better than the boy's strength. But in respect of participation of girls in the activities of the college, boy's number is less than the girls. In DLLE, out of 124 enrolled students, 40 girls participated against 84 boys which is again a good sign of girl's participation. In cultural event out of 95 participants, 50 girls participated against 45 boys,

which is quite ahead than the boys. Concern to scholarship, 6 girls received scholarship while 9 boys also awarded with the scholarship. Beside this the academic performance of girls is also excels in each semester. It justifies that there is no difference of Night College or Day College as girls takes part in various activities in better count of boys.

Women Development Cell:

There is an active women development cell in the college. The women development cell of the college aims at women empowerment and sensitization of all about sexual harassment. All are made aware about the legal implications of the same. The cell is actively involved in improving physical and mental health of the girl's students. A sanitary pad, vending machine is already installed in the girls common room for the convenience of the girl students.

The cell organized guest lecture on sexual harassment at workplace prevention and remedies on 13th march 2023. Dr. Gauri Kala, professor and an eminent layer was invited to deliver the lecture. Dr. Gauri Kala interacted with the students while discussing the topic. She focused on various types of sexual harassment at workplace and other public places. She discussed about verbal, nonverbal and physical harassment and preventions about the same. The students were curious to know about the various punishments for these offences. She also guided students on how to register cases of harassment with the police and consequences for the offence. They enquired whether comments of the dress of girl can be considered as harassment. They also enquired whether a dress code should be necessary in the degree college. The session was quite interactive.

Evidence and Success:

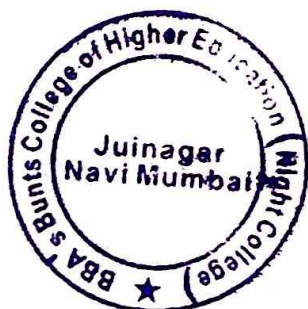


Problem Encountered:

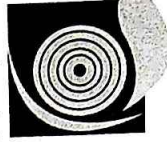
