Recommendations:

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Annual Report on Alumina Feedback (Academic Year 2020 - 21)

This report presents the findings and analysis of student feedback collected from the students of Alumina College. The feedback was obtained through an online survey distributed to all enrolled students.

Key findings indicate areas of strength within the institution, as well as opportunities for improvement.
